Perhaps the best indicator of an at large invitation to the NCAA Championship tournament is the <u>Ratings Percentage Index</u>, <u>Strength of Schedule</u> and <u>Quality</u> <u>Wins</u>. If the selections were made today, it would appear the seeds would be: (1) Duke; (2) Virginia; (3) Notre Dame; (4) Johns Hopkins; (5) Maryland; (6) Penn State; (7) Georgetown; (8) Cornell/Penn/Princeton/Yale. The at large invitations would go to Penn and Yale (if they do not win the IVY Championship) and probably Denver if it does not win the Big East. The following teams must win their conference title or face elimination: Princeton, Rutgers,
